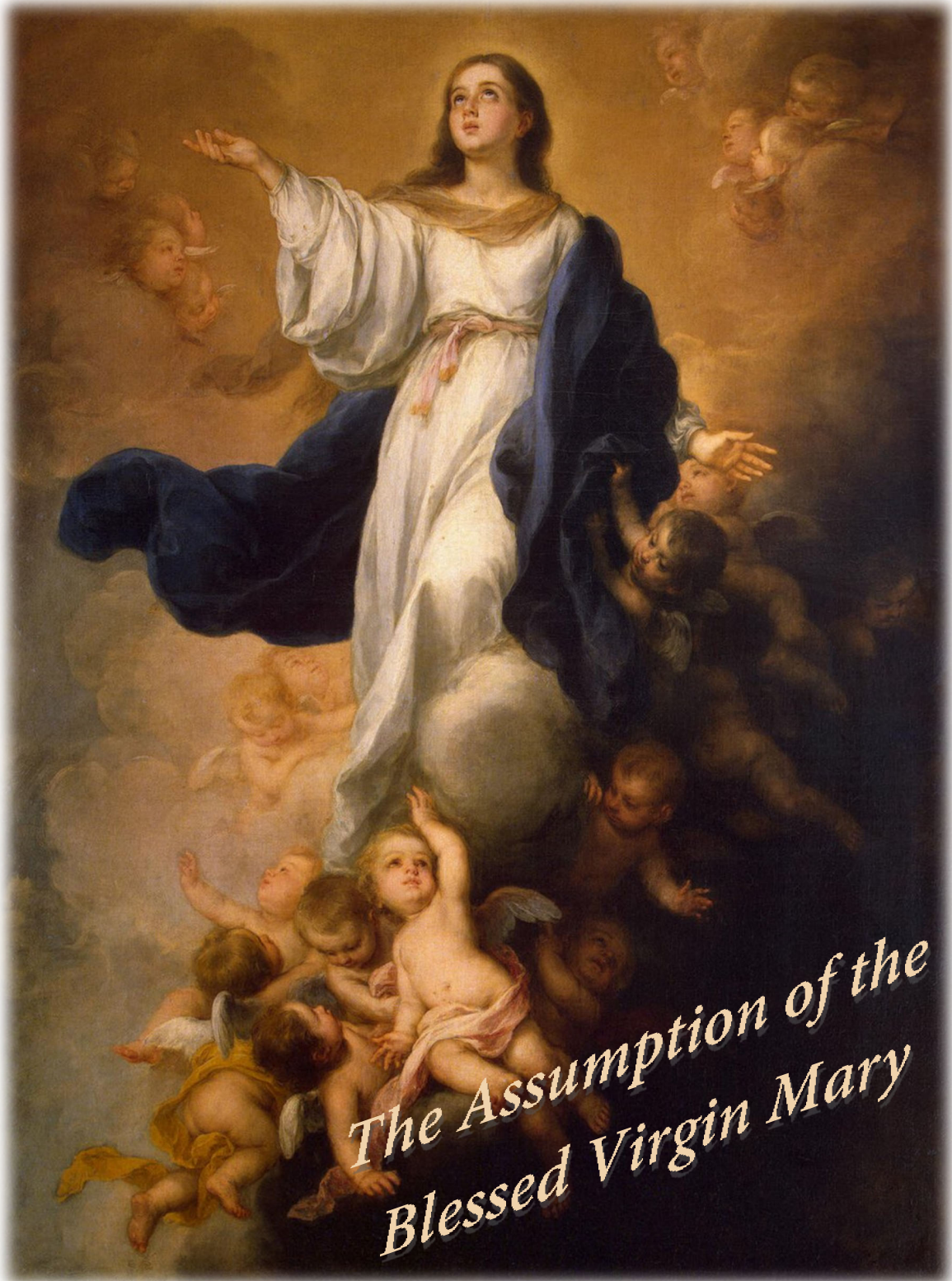

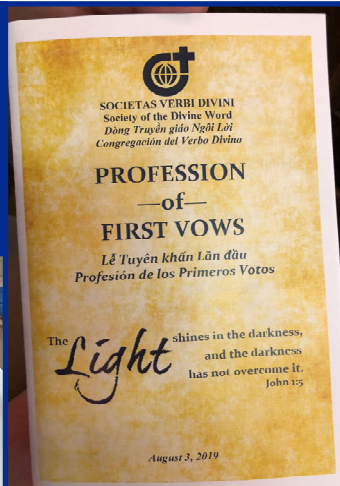

Catequesis del Papa Francisco sobre la Eucaristía: “Las ofrendas del pueblo santo”

Está bien que sean los fieles los que presenten el pan y el vino, porque estos representan la ofrenda espiritual de la Iglesia ahí recogida para la eucaristía. Y al respecto es significativo que, al ordenar un nuevo presbítero, el obispo, cuando le entrega el pan y el vino dice: “Recibe las ofrendas del pueblo santo para el sacrificio eucarístico” Por tanto, en los signos del pan y del vino el pueblo fiel pone la propia ofrenda en las manos del sacerdote, el cual la depone en el altar o mesa del Señor, “que es el centro de toda la Liturgia Eucarística”. Se ofrece por tanto el compromiso de los fieles a hacer de sí mismos, obedientes a la divina Palabra, “sacrificio agradable a Dios, Padre todopoderoso, por el bien de toda su santa Iglesia”. Así la vida de los fieles, su alabanza, su sufrimiento, su oración y su trabajo se unen a los de Cristo y a su total ofrenda, y adquieren así un valor nuevo. Ciertamente, nuestra ofrenda es poca cosa, pero Cristo necesita de este poco. Nos pide poco, el Señor, y nos da tanto. Nos pide poco. Nos pide, en la vida ordinaria, buena voluntad; nos pide corazón abierto; nos pide ganas de ser mejores para acogerle a Él que se ofrece a sí mismo a nosotros en la Eucaristía; nos pide estas ofrendas simbólicas que después se convertirán en su cuerpo y su sangre.....continúa
