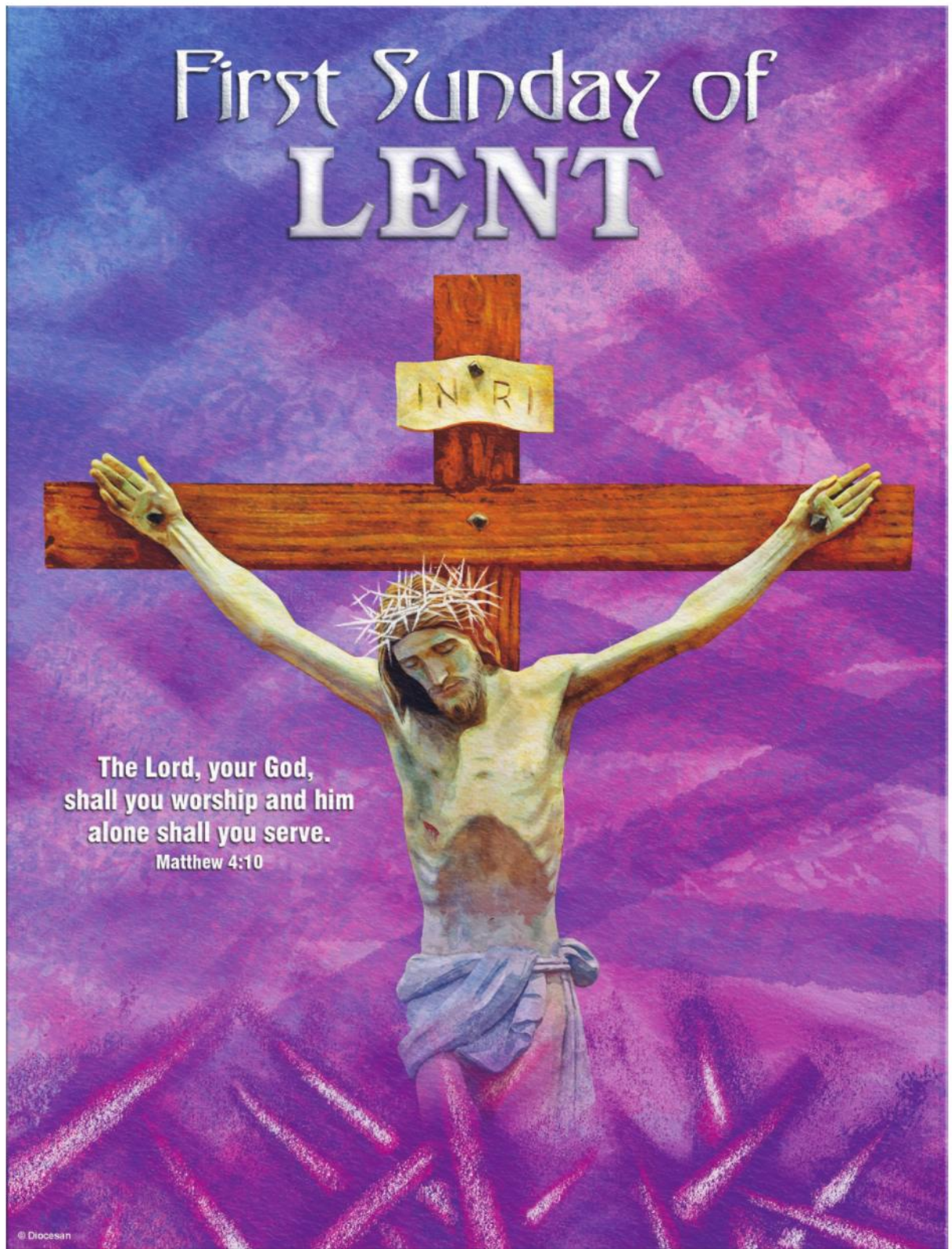

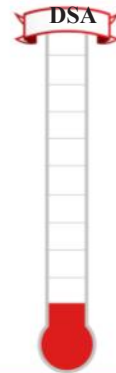

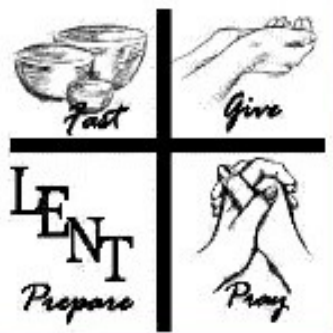

Lent is a time for:

Prayer: More time given to prayer during Lent should draw us closer to the Lord.

Fasting: Fasting is one of the most ancient practices linked to Lent. Fasting is more than a means of developing self-control. It is often an aid to prayer, as the pangs of hunger remind us of our hunger for God.

Almsgiving: It should be obvious at this point that almsgiving, the third traditional pillar, is linked to our baptismal commitment in the same way. It is a sign of our care for those in need and an expression of our gratitude for all that God has given to us

Keep track of your physical movement at home, at the mall, or at the gym, each day, while reflecting on Scripture. You can find suggestions for reflection on the parish website: OLQA.cc. If you are not mobile, prayers count for miles! Twenty minutes of prayer, which is about the length of a Rosary, chaplet, or morning Mass is equivalent to one mile.
