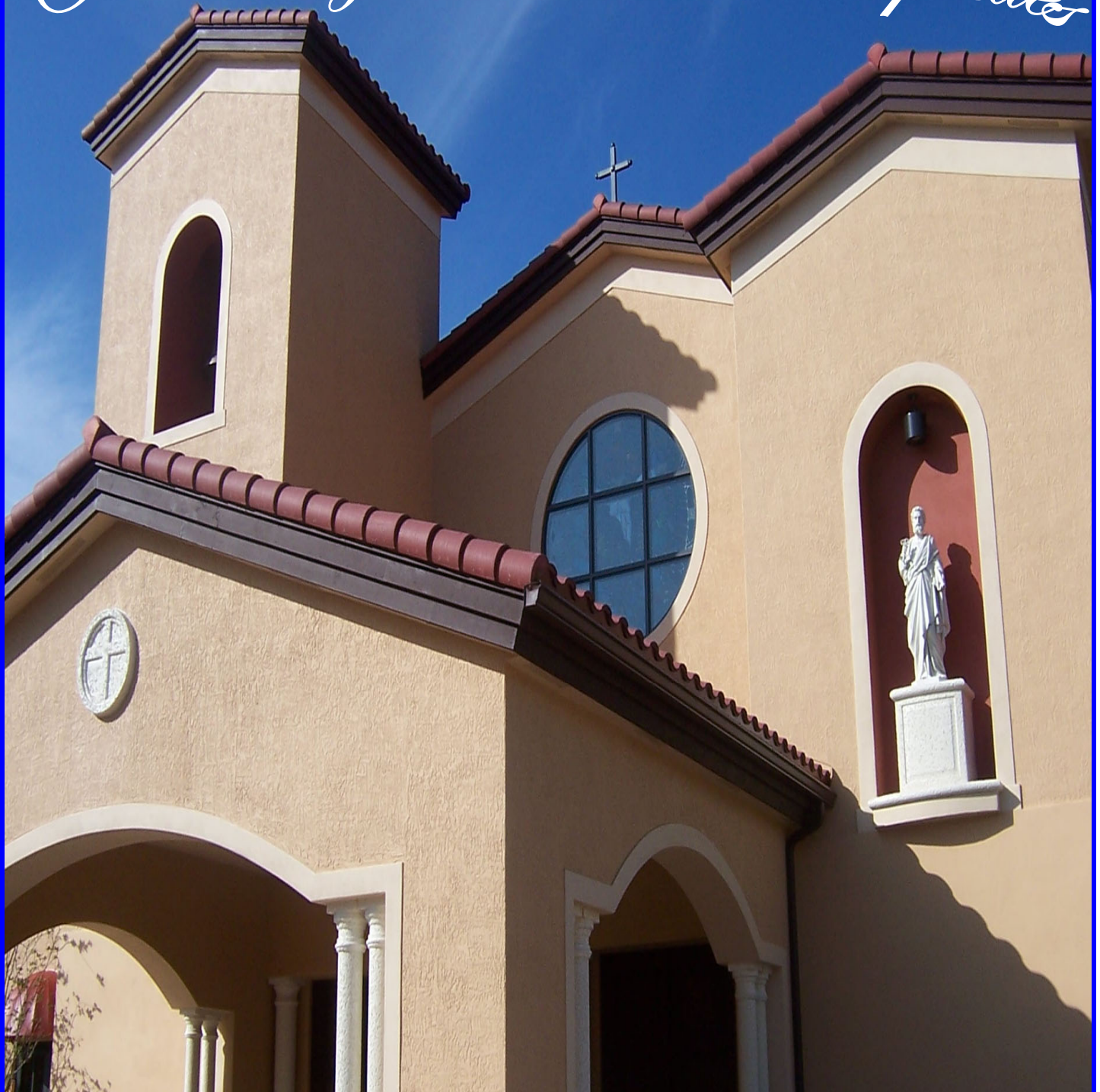

**SUNDAY READINGS:**

A number of years ago professional violinist, Joshua Bell, participated in an experiment. For 43 minutes, on his own Stradivarius, he played six of the world's best classical pieces, standing at a subway station in Washington, D.C. Of the 1,097 people who passed him that rush-hour morning, a total of seven stopped for even a moment to listen. According to the video which recorded the whole event, every single child who passed by wanted to stop but was hurried on by the accompanying adult. Could there be a better time than during Advent which begins next weekend to allow our minds to be blown open and recognize that Christ the King is Emmanuel, God with us, and is truly and intimately a part of who each of us is? But we will not recognize Him except by being in the present moment. But it will be even more difficult than in our opening story to focus on or pay attention to the God that dwells in our midst because during December we are zooming about busy about too many things. We need to consciously make a decision to do so. Prayer is an act of intentionality by which we attune ourselves to that Someone hidden within our souls and who transcends all time & space. We need only to open our inner eyes and recognize the presence of God in the love, joy, care, concern, honesty and peace of those around us, especially children. Constant busyness dulls our awareness of the presence of Emmanuel. Excessive attention to money and consumerism lessen our bond with family and with God. God is with each of us, if only we slow down long enough to look, see and listen.

**Protection from the Storm**

God our Father, Creator of the Universe and Lord over all creation, we humbly stand before you as your children in thanksgiving for your loving care and protection. We ask that you keep us safe from all hurricanes which may threaten us in the coming seasons. Protect us from all fear and anxiety of storms and give us an ardent trust and hope in Your love and mercy. You alone have the power to command the sea, the wind and the rain. You alone bring peace, calm, and safety. Father, we thank you in advance, for you are our only Refuge. We ask this through Christ, Your Son, Who lives and reigns with you and the Holy Spirit, one God, forever and ever. Amen. Mary, Queen of the Apostles, and Patroness of our Diocese, pray for us.

## **SACRAMENTAL INFORMATION**

**Baptisms:** Baptisms are celebrated twice each month. You need to come into the parish office to register for class. Ideally, preparation should begin during pregnancy. No confirmed dates are given before approval by the priest. In order to avoid disappointments, do not book travel plans with family, godparents, etc., until a confirmed date has been assigned at the conclusion of all stages of preparation. Parents needing annulments of marriages, or those not married, or those not married in the Church, will be assisted in addressing those issues before receiving a Baptismal date.

**Marriages:** You must be a registered and a supporting member of the parish for at least six months prior to your marriage. The date should not be set until a priest has been consulted.

**Sick and Homebound:** Please call the parish office to inform us of anyone hospitalized, homebound, or in need of the Sacraments.

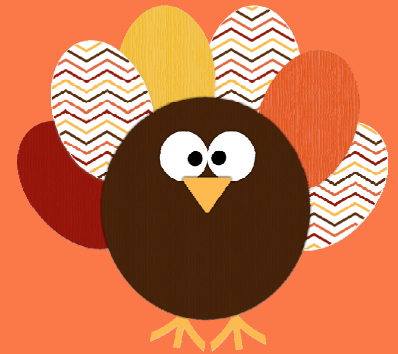

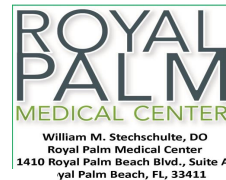
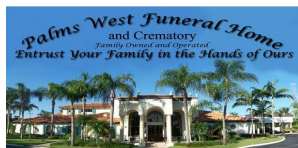
*Catholic Men for Jesus is hosting an Evening
