

Baptisms: Congratulations on the decision to baptize your child in the Catholic Faith! We are here to help you with the process. Sick and Homebound: We are blessed to have a group of volunteers in our parish who are happy to bring Holy Communion to the sick, the hospitalized and the homebound. Please call the parish office to make arrangements if you or your loved one would like a priest to visit with the Sacrament of Anointing.






