Catequesis del Papa Francisco sobre la Eucaristía: "Rezar como rezaba Jesús"

En la Última Cena, después de que Jesús tomó el pan y el cáliz del vino, y dio gracias a Dios, sabemos que «partió el pan». A esta acción corresponde, en la Liturgia Eucarística de la misa, la fracción del Pan, precedida por la oración que el Señor nos ha enseñado, es decir, por el «Padre Nuestro». Y así comenzamos los ritos de la Comunión, prolongando la alabanza y la súplica de la Oración eucarística con el rezo comunitario del «Padre Nuestro». Esta no es una de las muchas oraciones cristianas, sino que es la oración de los hijos de Dios: es la gran oración que nos enseñó Jesús. De hecho, entregado el día de nuestro bautismo, el «Padre Nuestro» nos hace resonar en nosotros esos mismos sentimientos que estaban en Cristo Jesús. Cuando nosotros rezamos el «Padre Nuestro», rezamos como rezaba Jesús. Es la oración que hizo Jesús, y nos la enseñó a nosotros; cuando los discípulos le dijeron: «Maestro, enséñanos a rezar como tú rezas». Y Jesús rezaba así. ¡Es muy hermoso rezar como Jesús! Formados en su divina enseñanza, osamos dirigirnos a Dios llamándolo «Padre» porque hemos renacido como sus hijos a través del agua y el Espíritu Santo. Ninguno, en realidad, podría llamarlo familiarmente «Abbà» «Padre» sin haber sido generado por Dios, sin la inspiración del Espíritu, como enseña san Pablo. Debemos pensar: nadie puede llamarlo «Padre» sin la inspiración del Espíritu. Cuántas veces hay gente que dice «Padre Nuestro», pero no sabe qué dice.....continúa
