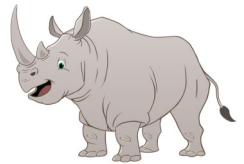

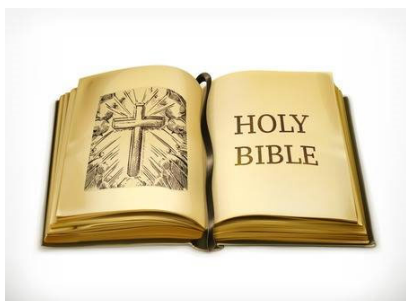

Catequesis del Papa Francisco sobre la Eucaristía: "Gloria a Dios en el cielo"

«Pues en el acto penitencial y después de la invitación a orar, cada uno se recoge en sí mismo; pero terminada la lectura o la homilía, todos meditan brevemente lo que escucharon; y después de la comunión, alaban a Dios en su corazón y oran» (Ibíd., 45). Tal vez venimos de días de cansancio, de alegría, de dolor, y queremos decírselo al Señor, invocar su ayuda, pedir que nos esté cercano; tenemos amigos o familiares enfermos o que atraviesan pruebas difíciles; deseamos confiar a Dios el destino de la Iglesia y del mundo. Y para esto sirve el breve silencio antes de que el sacerdote, recogiendo las intenciones de cada uno, exprese en voz alta a Dios, en nombre de todos, la oración común que concluye los ritos de introducción haciendo de hecho «la colecta» de las intenciones. Recomendando esto a los sacerdotes. Sin este silencio, corremos el riesgo de descuidar el recogimiento del alma. El sacerdote recita esta súplica, esta oración de colecta, con los brazos extendidos y la actitud del orante, asumida por los cristianos desde el final de los primeros siglos para imitar al Cristo con los brazos abiertos sobre la madera de la cruz. Y allí, Cristo es el Orante y es también la oración. En el crucifijo reconocemos al Sacerdote que ofrece a Dios la oración que desea, es decir, la obediencia filial. En el Rito Romano, las oraciones son concisas pero ricas de significado: se pueden hacer tantas meditaciones hermosas sobre estas oraciones. Que la liturgia pueda convertirse para todos nosotros en una verdadera escuela de oración
