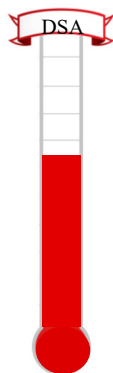
Church Mice

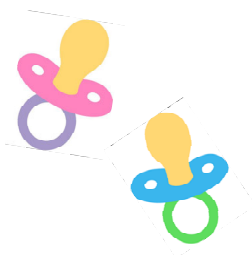

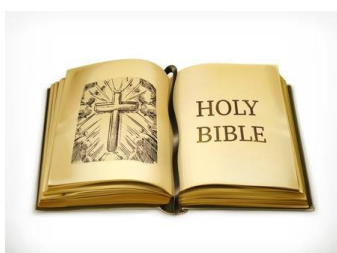

Catequesis del Papa Francisco sobre la Eucaristía: “conocer los signos para vivir plenamente la misa”

La misa está formada de dos partes, que son la Liturgia de la Palabra y la Liturgia eucarística, tan estrechamente unidas entre ellas que forman un único acto de culto. La celebración es por tanto un único cuerpo y no se puede separar, pero para una mejor comprensión trataré de explicar sus diferentes momentos, cada uno de los cuales es capaz de tocar e implicar una dimensión de nuestra unidad. Es necesario conocer estos santos signos para vivir plenamente la misa y saborear toda su belleza. Cuando el pueblo está reunido, la celebración se abre con los ritos introductorios, incluidas la entrada de los celebrantes o del celebrante: el saludo, el acto penitencial, donde nosotros pedimos perdón por nuestros pecado, el Kyrie eleison, el himno del Gloria y la oración colecta: la colecta de las intenciones de oración de todos los pueblos. Su fin —de estos ritos introductorios— es hacer «que los fieles reunidos en la unidad construyan la comunión y se dispongan debidamente a escuchar la Palabra de Dios y a celebrar dignamente la Eucaristía. La misa empieza con la señal de la cruz, con estos ritos introductorios, porque allí empezamos a adorar a Dios como comunidad. Y por esto es importante prever no llegar tarde, más bien antes, para preparar el corazón a este rito, a esta celebración de la comunidad. El sacerdote con los otros ministros llega en procesión al presbiterio, y aquí saluda el altar con una reverencia y, en signo de veneración, lo besa. ¿Por qué? Porque el altar es Cristo: es figura de Cristo
