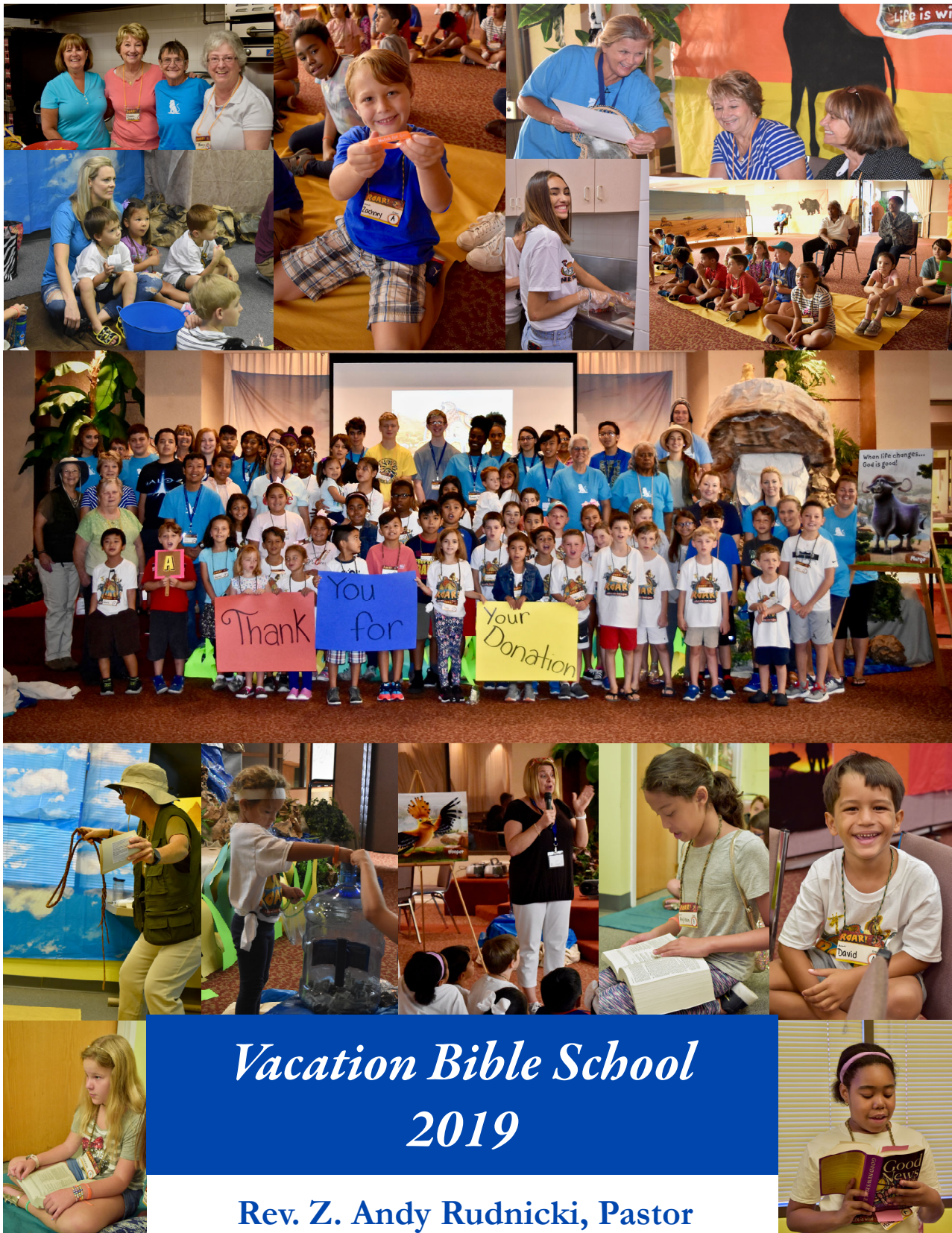

WANT TO LEARN MORE ABOUT YOUR CATHOLIC FAITH?

The School of Christian Formation for the Diocese of Palm Beach is offering a series of classes and programs for adult Catholics who wish to learn more about the rich traditions of their faith.

Each class meets from 7:15 to 9:15 on Wednesday evenings for a total of six classes (twelve hours) taught during the Fall and Spring Semesters. You may attend individual courses for credit or follow the entire three-year program which concludes with the granting of a certificate of completion awarded by Bishop Barbarito at the school's annual graduation ceremony. The Diocese strongly recommends these courses for all the faithful, especially those serving in liturgical, educational and spiritual ministries. The registration fee is \$10 and textbooks range from \$10 to \$20 per course.

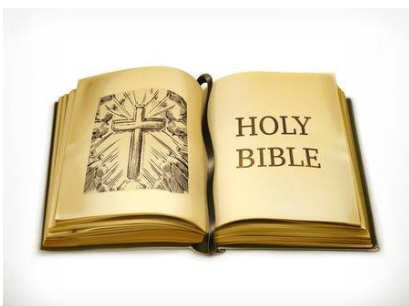

Ministerio Hispano

Catequesis del Papa Francisco sobre la Eucaristía:

“La Palabra de Jesús en el Evangelio está viva”

Nos levantamos para escuchar el Evangelio: es Cristo quien nos habla, allí. Y por esto nosotros estamos atentos, porque es un coloquio directo. Es el Señor que nos habla. Por tanto, en la misa no leemos el Evangelio para saber cómo fueron las cosas, sino que escuchamos el Evangelio para tomar conciencia de lo que Jesús hizo y dijo una vez; y esa Palabra está viva, la Palabra de Jesús que está en el Evangelio está viva y llega a mi corazón. Escribe san Agustín que «la boca de Cristo es el Evangelio. Él reina en el cielo, pero no cesa de hablar en la tierra» Para hacer llegar su mensaje, Cristo se sirve también de la palabra del sacerdote que, después del Evangelio, da la homilía. ¿Qué es la homilía? Es «retomar ese diálogo que ya está entablado entre el Señor y su pueblo» para que encuentre realización en la vida. ¡La auténtica exégesis del Evangelio es nuestra vida santa! La palabra del Señor termina su recorrido haciéndose carne en nosotros, traducándose en obras, como sucedió en María y en los santos. La Palabra del Señor entra por las orejas, llega al corazón y va a las manos, a las buenas obras. El contexto litúrgico «exige que la predi- cación oriente a la asamblea, y también al predicador, a una comunión con Cristo en la Eucaristía que transforme la vida»
