Deacon's Corner

What kind of soil does your heart represent? Is your heart the path, the rocky ground, the thorns, or the good soil? I believe before we start answering these questions we need to remember that we are “different” at different times and moments of our lives. One thing is clear: we can only accept the seed (word) according to our dispositions - the condition of the soil of our hearts.

Our process of conversion is to work to prepare our soil (heart) to receive the seed (word) so that it may take root and bring forth faith in abundance. We can never cease our task of preparing our hearts to receive God’s love. The tilling, watering, and maintaining of the soil never ceases. We are never finished in our process of becoming ready to receive the word in our hearts and allowing it to take root and bring forth fruit.

The amazing thing is that God never stops sowing the seed. God doesn’t do it only once. God doesn’t give up if it fails among the thorns. No, our God sows the seed over and over again. God never gives up on us and never casts us aside. God’s mercy and love know no limits. Our God has unending patience and understanding. God rejoices at the beautiful times when the seed reaches some good soil that is ready to do some work for his Kingdom.
