

The bake sale relies on donations from our parishioners to sell at the festival. Do you and/or your child like to bake? This is a great opportunity to make a favorite dessert or treat to share. Cupcakes, brownies, muffins, and cookies are always winners, but any small, portable baked items are also good ideas. However our parishioners step up to the task, there are always creative cakes and other goodies (chocolate dipped bacon...amazing). Coffee is also available at the Bake Shoppe.

If your recipe contains common food allergens (e.g. nuts, dairy), please clearly label the item. Also, we do not have refrigeration at the bake sale table. If you want to make something requiring refrigeration, please take a picture of your dessert to be placed at the table and we can keep your item refrigerated until needed. As the festival is over two weekends, we ask that you sign up which weekend you would like to bring your treat; this way we can plan to have enough to sell each weekend. Sign up sheets will be available when we sell presale tickets in November. Donations can be dropped off at the **Bake Shoppe** table located in the roundabout circle (south side of the pavilion).




