


Sacramental Information

Deacon's Corner

We see Jesus responding to the plea of Peter: "We have put aside everything to follow you!" Jesus promises Peter that he will receive a hundred times more than the wonderful things they have left.

Make no mistake about it, Peter and the others left a lot of things to follow Jesus. Peter's fishing business was his pride and joy. Probably his cousins and friends took over, but he was still away from it and he missed it. He left behind his home and his family. He might have gone days, even weeks at a time, not seeing his wife and children, and that was a deep hardship. There was the money problems that his absence created as he took less of the profit because of the extra hands hired to fill in for him. Peter didn't even understand yet what discipleship would eventually cost him - his very life. But Jesus said: "Come follow me."

Our Lord says to each of us: "Come follow me." We are all asked to give up a lot if we want to walk with Him. In whatever our vocation the great command is to: love the way Jesus loved. When we love our spouses, children, friends, and parishioners in that way we give up so much of our own will, selfishness, egoism, and prejudice. When our life is lived like Jesus' life - giving ourselves to others - the cost is high, but the rewards are beyond our wildest dreams.

Breast Cancer Awareness Month

October is Breast Cancer Awareness Month.

Through education and prevention we can all help fight this disease. Every woman should be doing monthly self-breast exams. Call your health care provider if you notice a lump, thickening, or skin changes.

This week make it your goal to call at least 5 women age 40 or over and ask if she has had a mammogram in the past year. Remind her that early detection is the best way to control breast cancer. Urge her to see a doctor or get a mammogram in the next 2 weeks.

This only takes a few minutes, but can save a life. For more information contact the American Cancer Society at 1-800-227-2345.

FYI: breast cancer is not limited to women only; men should also do monthly self-breast exams.

XXVIII Domingo: Evita los pecados de omisión

La historia del joven rico ha sido interpretada a veces como la expresión de los dos caminos que habría en la vida cristiana: el del laico que busca la salvación cumpliendo los mínimos, es decir: observando los mandamientos; y el de aquellos otros que aspiran a algo más, a la consagración religiosa o sacerdotal, que exige un seguimiento más radical de Cristo. No creo que esa interpretación sea correcta, porque para todos los cristianos rigen los mismos preceptos: los mandamientos por un lado y la ley del amor por otro. No es verdad que el camino del laico sea el del aprobado y el del religioso o sacerdote el del notable o el sobresaliente. Todos estamos llamados a la misma vocación, la de la santidad. A ella vamos a llegar cuando observamos los mandamientos -los mínimos- y cuando procuramos practicar la caridad -el máximo. La caridad, el amor, es para todos y no sólo para unos cuantos elegidos que quizá algún día veneraremos en los altares. Es para todos los bautizados igualmente válido el precepto de amar a los enemigos, de dar limosna a quien lo necesita, de consolar al que sufre, de vestir al desnudo, de acompañar al solitario, de cumplir con las propias obligaciones, de poner en las propias espaldas algo del peso ajeno para que el prójimo pueda ver aliviada su carga. No hay un camino de segunda y uno de primera. Hay un solo camino cristiano: el del amor a Dios y al prójimo.
