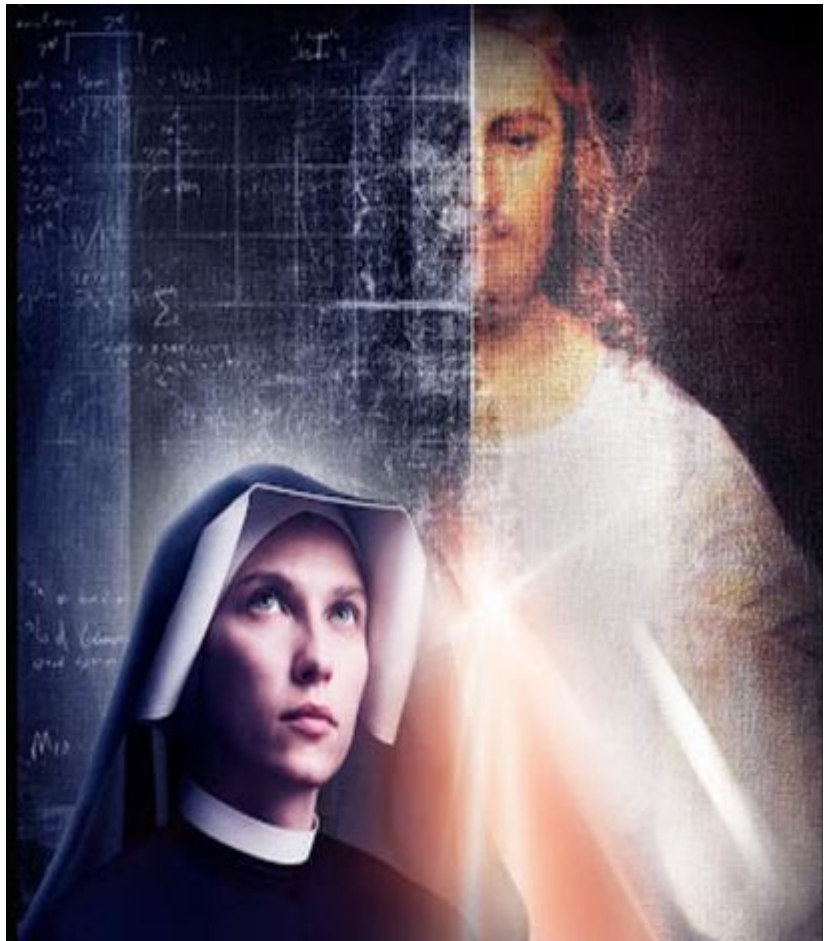
Faustina Film Hits Movie Theaters Nationwide on October 28

In the 1930s, our Lord revealed to an unknown religious sister a message for our times. To an age marked by conflict, despair, lack of respect for human life and dignity, and in need of His forgiveness and merciful love, He said, "Mankind will not have peace until it turns with trust to My mercy" (*Diary of Saint Maria Faustina Kowalska*, 300).

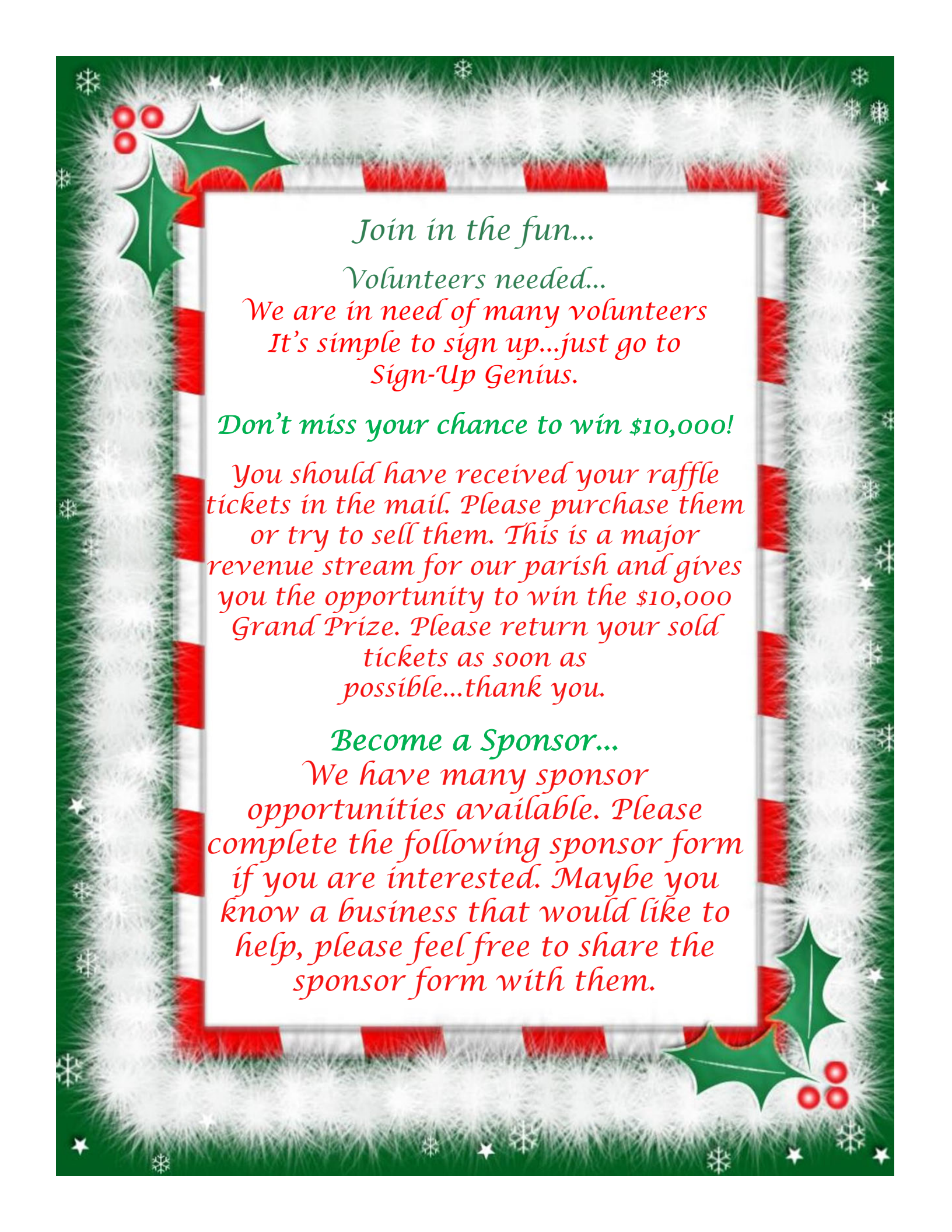

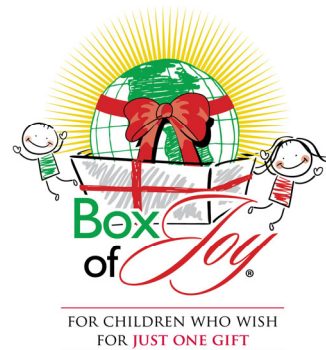

Catequesis del Papa Francisco sobre la Eucaristía: "Dichosos los invitados al banquete de bodas del Cordero"

Nos ayuda san Agustín a comprenderlo, cuando habla de la luz recibida al escuchar decir de Cristo: "Manjar soy de grandes: crece y me comerás. Y tú no me transformarás en ti como al manjar de tu carne, sino tú te transformarás en mí". Cada vez que nosotros hacemos la comunión, nos parecemos más a Jesús, nos transformamos más en Jesús. Como el pan y el vino se convierten en Cuerpo y Sangre del Señor, así cuantos le reciben con fe son transformados en eucaristía viviente. Al sacerdote que, distribuyendo la eucaristía, te dice: "El Cuerpo de Cristo", tú respondes: "Amén", o sea reconoces la gracia y el compromiso que conlleva convertirse en Cuerpo de Cristo. Porque cuando tú recibes la eucaristía te conviertes en cuerpo de Cristo. Es bonito, esto; es muy bonito. Mientras nos une a Cristo, arrancándonos de nuestros egoísmos, la comunión nos abre y une a todos aquellos que son una sola cosa en Él. Este es el prodigio de la comunión: ¡nos convertimos en lo que recibimos! La Iglesia desea vivamente que también los fieles reciban el Cuerpo del Señor con hostias consagradas en la misma misa; y el signo del banquete eucarístico se expresa con mayor plenitud si la santa comunión se hace bajo las dos especies, incluso sabiendo que la doctrina católica enseña que bajo una sola especie se recibe a Cristo todo e íntegro.... continúa
