SACRAMENTAL INFORMATION

Baptisms: Baptisms are celebrated twice each month. You need to come into the parish office to register for class. Ideally, preparation should begin during pregnancy. No confirmed dates are given before approval by the priest. In order to avoid disappointments, do not book travel plans with family, godparents, etc., until a confirmed date has been assigned at the conclusion of all stages of preparation. Parents needing annulments of marriages, or those not married, or those not married in the Church, will be assisted in addressing those issues before receiving a Baptismal date.

Marriages: You must be a registered and a supporting member of the parish for at least six months prior to your marriage. The date should not be set until a priest has been consulted.

Sick and Homebound: Please call the parish office to inform us of anyone hospitalized, homebound, or in need of the Sacraments.



Prudence & Priorities

It doesn't matter which national poll you consider, our nation's jobs and economy are the number one priority for Americans. Because much of our quality of life relies on good wages, it makes sense that this is always at the top of the list. The same was true for the Dishonest Steward in today's Gospel. He had squandered his master's money. When he was confronted and called to account for his wastefulness, he comes up with a plan for his financial future. The master praises the steward, not for his dishonesty, but for his initiative, quick action, and prudence in responding to the crisis. The Gospel warns us that we are more eager and willing to respond to practical issues of self-interest in our world, instead of those of our spiritual life. As Catholics, we are called to respond to the crisis of sin in our world, and recognize Jesus among us. We are called to use the "dishonest wealth" of this world through charity and almsgiving, so that we will be "welcomed into eternal dwellings." Everything we have belongs to God, but many of us continue to manage our lives like the Dishonest Steward. America is one of the richest and most generous nations on earth, but the largest group of people living in poverty are our children. In Palm Beach County alone, more than 40% of households don't make enough money. When we are called to "prepare a full account" of how we managed our gifts from God, will he welcome us into our "eternal dwelling?" Now is the time to respond. Now is the time to use what God has given us for his glory, and to build up his kingdom. Now is the time to change our priorities from the "self-interest" message of the world, and put Jesus first. This week, let's **make one action step** that will change our priorities, and better manage the gifts of time, talent, and treasure that God has given us.

We ask that you keep us safe from all hurricanes which may threaten us in the coming seasons. You alone bring peace, calm, and safety. Father, we thank you in advance, for you are our only Refuge. We ask this through Christ, Your Son, Who lives and reigns with you and the Holy Spirit, one God, forever and ever. Amen. Mary, Queen of the Apostles, and Patroness of our Diocese, pray for us.




