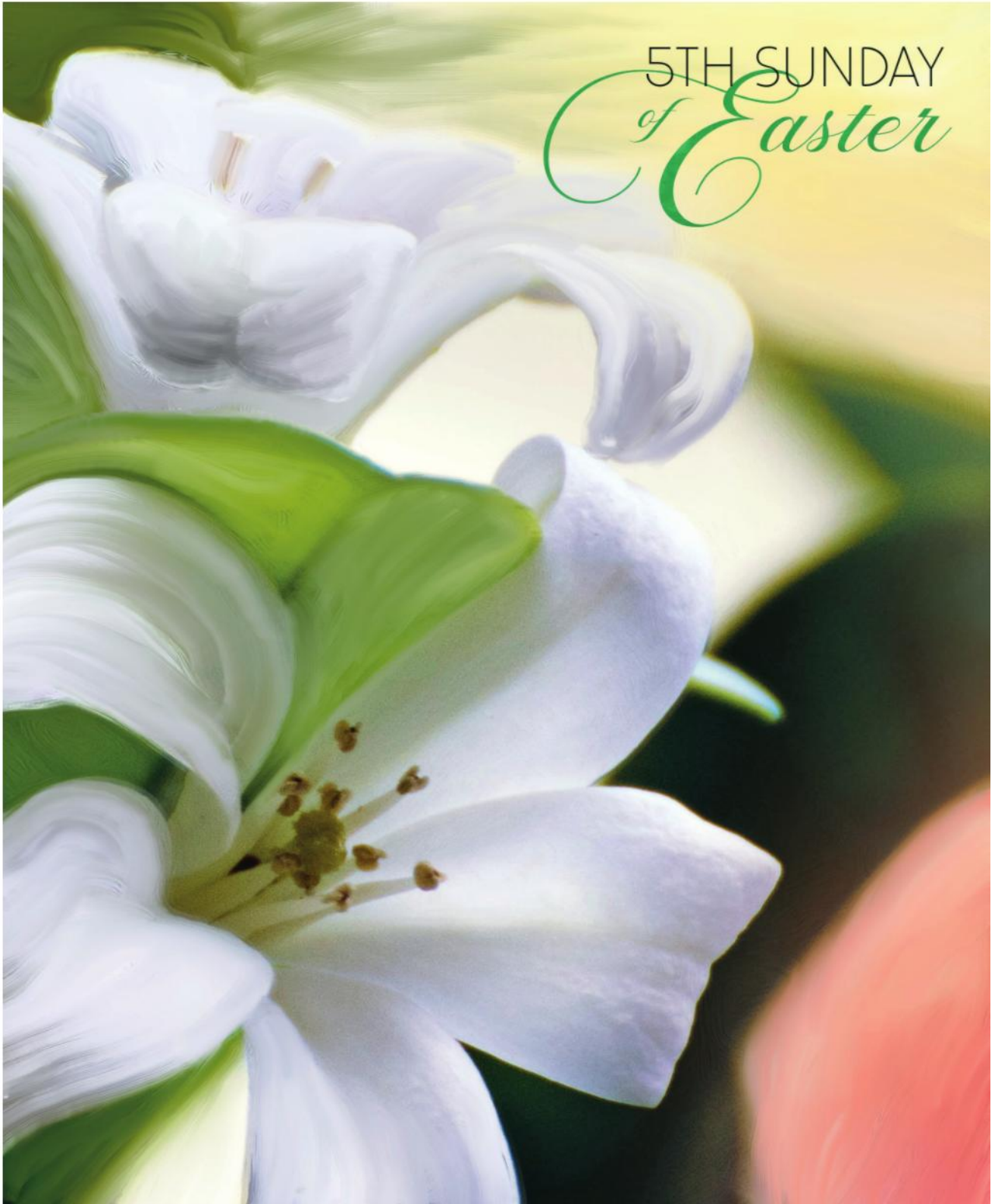

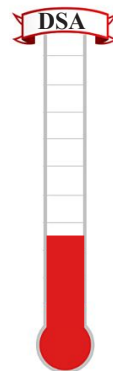

Next weekend, a special collection for the Catholic Communication Campaign will be taken up in our Diocese. A portion of the CCC collection will support national communication efforts of the United States Bishops, while part of it will fund our interactive diocesan communications projects, such as the weekly Televised Catholic Mass, the *Florida Catholic*, the Diocese's vibrant social media presence, and website (www.DiocesePB.org).

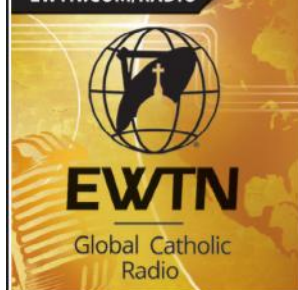
