Title: Director of Religious Education

Essential Duties and Responsibilities

Develop, implement and administer the parish's Religious Education Program for grades 1-9, utilizing innovative programs not restricted to "classroom models" of education
Recruit, train, and supervise volunteers (e.g. small group leaders, catechists, adult helpers)
Provide teaching materials, calendars and schedules on a timely basis to those involved
Ensure that records of both students and programs are kept and maintained
Coordinate the First Communion/First Reconciliation/Confirmation preparation
Register families, collect fees and provide for family/parent meetings
Prepare or offer input on an annual budget and monthly grade level activities and updates
Plan, coordinate and lead Vacation Bible School each year
Counsel, advise, and visit with students, parents/guardians, catechists if problems or concerns arise
Ensure all "Protecting God's Children" policies and procedures are strictly followed
Coordinate Sunday Children's Liturgy of the Word
Communicate regularly with pastor, business manager and appropriate staff members

Qualifications

Adhere to the Diocese of Palm Beach Code of Conduct with emphasis on confidentiality and the ability to exercise discretion and good judgment
Bachelor's degree or equivalent preferred in Theology, Religious Studies, Education or related field
Experience in leading parish catechetical ministry is preferred.
Must have excellent verbal and written communication skills
Must demonstrate strong social media skills
Proficiency in MS Office Suite, including Word, Excel, Outlook and Internet
Ability to multi-task, work independently and make responsible judgment calls
Strong interpersonal skills

Physical Requirements

Frequent extended periods of sitting

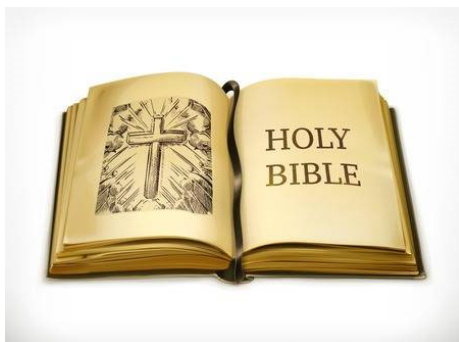

Catequesis del Papa Francisco sobre la Eucaristía:

“La Palabra de Dios penetra en los corazones abiertos”

Sabemos que la palabra del Señor es una ayuda indispensable para no perdersenos, como reconoce el salmista que, dirigido al Señor, confiesa: «Para mis pies antorcha es tu palabra, luz para mi sendero» (Salmos 119, 105). ¿Cómo podremos afrontar nuestra peregrinación terrena, con sus cansancios y sus pruebas, sin ser regularmente nutridos e iluminados por la Palabra de Dios que resuena en la liturgia? Ciertamente no basta con escuchar con los oídos, sin acoger en el corazón la semilla de la divina Palabra, permitiéndole dar fruto. Recordemos la parábola del sembrador y de los diferentes resultados según los distintos tipos de terreno (cf. Marcos 4, 14-20). La acción del Espíritu, que hace eficaz la respuesta, necesita de corazón que se dejen trabajar y cultivar, de forma que lo escuchado en misa pase en la vida cotidiana, según la advertencia del apóstol Santiago: «Poned por obra la Palabra y no os contentéis solo con oírla, engañándoos a vosotros mismos» (Santiago 1, 22). La Palabra de Dios hace un camino dentro de nosotros. La escuchamos con los oídos y pasa al corazón; no permanece en los oídos, debe ir al corazón; y del corazón pasa a las manos, a las buenas obras. Este es el recorrido que hace la Palabra de Dios: de los oídos al corazón y a las manos. Aprendamos estas cosas. ¡Gracias!
