Sacramental Information

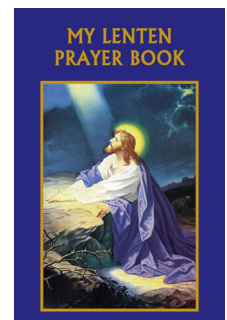

Catequesis del Papa sobre la Eucaristía: La Misa es el momento privilegiado para estar con Jesús

La misa es oración, es más, es la oración por excelencia, la más alta, la más sublime, y el mismo tiempo la más «concreta». De hecho es el encuentro de amor con Dios mediante su Palabra y el Cuerpo y Sangre de Jesús. Es un encuentro con el Señor. La oración es sobre todo diálogo, relación personal con Dios. Rezar, como todo verdadero diálogo, es también saber permanecer en silencio, en los diálogos hay momentos de silencio, en silencio junto a Jesús. Es el momento de recogerse en el corazón para prepararse al encuentro con Jesús. Y del misterioso silencio de Dios brota su Palabra que resuena en nuestro corazón. Jesús responde que la primera cosa necesaria para rezar es saber decir «Padre». Pero para poder aprender, es necesario reconocer humildemente que necesitamos ser instruidos, y decir con sencillez: Señor, enséñame a rezar. Este es el primer punto: ser humildes, reconocerse hijos, descansar en el Padre, fiarse de Él. Para entrar en el Reino de los cielos es necesario hacerse pequeños como niños. Para entrar en el Reino de los cielos es necesario dejarse maravillar. nosotros vamos a la misa no a un museo, vamos a un encuentro vivo con el Señor. ¿Nosotros tenemos este deseo? De hecho se puede perder fácilmente porque, a causa de tantas actividad, de tantos proyectos que realizar, al final nos queda poco tiempo y perdemos de vista lo que es fundamental: nuestra vida del corazón, nuestra vida espiritual, nuestra vida que es encuentro con el Señor en la oración.

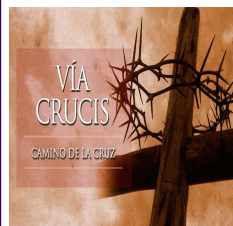
