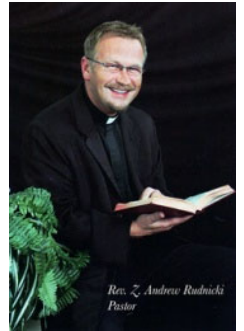

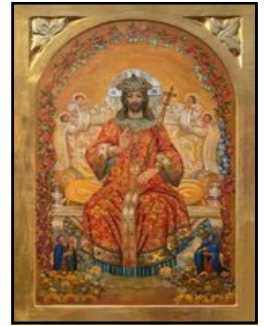

Catequesis del Papa Francisco sobre la Eucaristía: "Dichosos los invitados al banquete de bodas del Cordero"

La comunión sacramental: no la comunión espiritual, que puedes hacerla en tu casa diciendo: "Jesús, yo quisiera recibirte espiritualmente". ¡No! la comunión sacramental, con el cuerpo y la sangre de Cristo. Celebramos la Eucaristía para nutrirnos de Cristo, que se nos da a sí mismo, tanto en la Palabra como en el Sacramento del altar, para conformarnos a Él. Lo dice el Señor mismo: "El que come mi carne y bebe mi sangre, permanece en mí y yo en él". De hecho, el gesto de Jesús que dona a sus discípulos su Cuerpo y Sangre en la última Cena, continúa todavía hoy a través del ministerio del sacerdote y del diácono, ministros ordinarios de la distribución a los hermanos del Pan de la vida y del Cáliz de la salvación. En la misa, después de haber partido el Pan consagrado, es decir, el cuerpo de Jesús, el sacerdote lo muestra a los fieles invitándoles a participar en el banquete eucarístico. Conocemos las palabras que resuenan desde el santo altar: «Dichosos los invitados a la Cena del Señor: he aquí el Cordero de Dios, que quita el pecado del mundo». Inspirado en un pasaje del Apocalipsis "Dichosos los invitados al banquete de bodas del Cordero": dice "bodas" porque Jesús es el esposo de la Iglesia, esta invitación nos llama a experimentar la íntima unión con Cristo, fuente de alegría y de santidad.... continúa
